**CIRCULAR**

**Eligibility for admission into certain Elective Subjects in Class XI :**

In order to be eligible for offering an Elective Subject, as specified in column (2) of the table below, a student must obtain the minimum percentage of marks in the subject, as noted in column (3) of that table :

**T A B L E**

Sl No.	Elective Subject	Minimum percentage of marks to be obtained in Madhyamik Pariksha or equivalent examination
1.	Mathematics or Statistics of Business Economics including Business Mathematics	*35% or above (Grade B) in Mathematics
2.	Biological Sciences	*35% or above (Grade B) in Life Science
3.	Physics or Chemistry or both	*35% or above (Grade B) in Physical Science
4.	Geography	*35% or above (Grade B) in Geography
5.	Computer Science	*35% or above (Grade B) in Mathematics

\* West Bengal Board of Secondary Education has introduced seven point indirect grade system of evaluation from 2009. The changes made in the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education regulation became imperative to make conformity with the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education and West Bengal Board of Madrasah Education introduced systems.
